

Join the Westwood Historical Society

The Westwood Historical Society, Inc. was established in 1965 to ensure that the unique history of Westwood would be preserved and shared with the community. The Society is a non-profit organization which promotes historical work, research, and education.

The restored 1845 Greek Revival style Fisher School is the headquarters of the Society and is used for meetings, exhibits, and other historical and cultural activities. The lower level houses the Society's treasured collection of items pertaining to Westwood's history. The Society's programs are open to the public and the building is handicap accessible.

The schoolhouse also provides a living history setting for school classes. For example, all of Westwood's third grade classes visit the Fisher School for an "1800s School Day" each year in May. Students step back in time to sit at old-fashioned desks, use individual slates, write with ink and quill pens and play typical 19th century games.

The Society relies on membership dues and donations to ensure that Westwood's heritage can be preserved and shared. Annual membership dues are an important source of revenue and cover the period from May 1st through April 30th of the following year. Contributions above the basic Single or Family Memberships (shown below) will help with the upkeep of the building as well as conservation of artifacts. The Society is eligible to receive employer matching gifts.
